The Battle of an Addict

Nearly three years ago a family was inducted into the OTF program. The student's father suffered from drug addiction, making the home environment extremely unstable for the student. The addict had been to rehab previously, however, he would get discharged before he could even recover.

Last year he was inducted into the OTF Healthcare program through which he was admitted at Aas Trust to receive the care he needed to overcome his addiction. After 11 months of rehabilitation and extremely strict supervision he was weaned back into normalcy.

Currently, he has overcome his addiction and is now sober for nearly one year. OTF continues to work with this family and aims to give them a better life and improve opportunities for the parents and their children. It was this father's dedication and commitment to improve himself that brought him this far. OTF aims to keep him just as motivated for his search for employment so that he can support his family and they can have access to a better life.
