COVID-19 Relief Efforts —

We would like to thank all our donors for the overwhelming response. Thanks to your support we are now aiming to serve 20,000 families, we have already served 15,000+ families. Since the lockdown has eased and many daily wage earners have resumed work, therefore we have slowed down the drive and are focusing more towards the Education Emergency.

Our beneficiaries comprise a wide spectrum – daily wage earners, workers in the travel industry/catering, white collar families, transgender, hearing impaired, families of children with Down Syndrome, Hindu and Christian communities.

In these uncertain times, fundraising has become more challenging therefore, we appeal to our donors to please come forward and help since despite COVID-19, our students must study and fight bravely to find normalcy in the face of this pandemic.

Prior to the pandemic we aimed to provide 100 additional scholarships, however, due to the economic crisis which has led to increased pay cuts and unemployment many students have been unable to afford education. Through our COVID-19 Education emergency we aim to provide 300 additional scholarships to our 2020 target. Allhumdullilah we have managed to raise funds for 300 out of 400 scholarships.

We still need to raise funds for 100 scholarships, we urge you all to come forward and support us.

The eldest of three siblings, he is the son of an electrician and a teacher. After doing Bachelors in Mechanical Engineering from National University of Sciences and Technology (NUST), he hopes that an MBA will help him find a better job. He had to quit his job at Ayesha Steel to study further and now supports himself at a bare minimum of Rs. 20,000 by giving tuitions. His dedication and commitment to his future had helped him secure a scholarship for the first semester from another renowned entity and now just needs our support till graduation.
