And to all our partners supporting us this Ramadan!



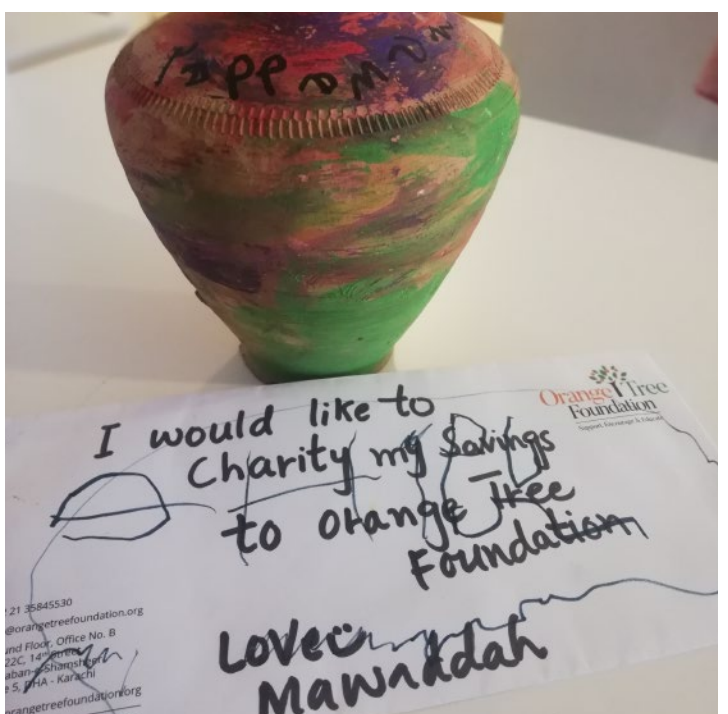
KFC Scholarship Program
